TollGuard Instructions

1. Pick up the handset, and listen for the dial tone.
2.  Use the normal direct-dialing procedures to place any call – local or long distance.
3.  If the number you've dialed is long distance, you will hear a message instructing you to enter your PIN. Enter your PIN, and press #. Your call will then be completed.
4. If your PIN has not been correctly entered, a message will tell you to try again. If the PIN is not correctly entered on a second attempt, a recording will tell you that the phone line is toll restricted, and the call will be disconnected.

Note: TollGuard does not allow you to unblock your toll restriction by using your PIN when you place an operator-assisted call. Operators will allow you to place calling card and collect calls only; they will not accept your PIN.
